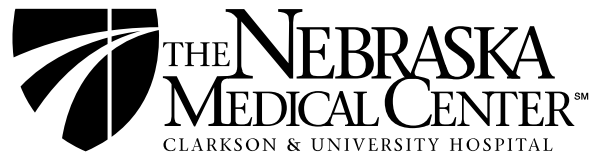


# Dilemmas in Wound Care
